Comment	<p>Siting of new cemeteries is always a difficult issue, bearing in mind the requirement for suitable ground conditions, accessibility, and decorum. It is therefore likely to take a relatively long time to identify, acquire, and prepare a new cemetery such that it is in a fit state to receive first burials and does not seem like a building site.</p> <p>It is therefore important that ABC identifies potential sites in this plan, and conducts relevant assessments, such that a new cemetery will be available well before existing provision reaches capacity in relatively short timescale of "the early twenties"</p>
