Comment	<p>The part of this site called Orchard Farm (submitted site KE2) is assessed as Grade 1 agricultural land (Sustainability appraisal (SA) and Strategic Environment Assessment (SEA) of the Ashford Borough Local Plan, Appendix 3c - Ashford Urban Edge and Strategic Sites.</p> <p>NPPF 112 states that "Local planning authorities should take into account the economic and other benefits of the best and most versatile agricultural land. Where significant development of agricultural land is demonstrated to be necessary, local planning authorities should seek to use areas of poorer quality land in preference to that of a higher quality."</p> <p>The draft Plan makes no attempt to assess "the economic and other benefits" of this best and most versatile agricultural land, and therefore does not comply with NPPF 112.</p> <p>The is nothing in the Plan to show why this particular parcel of high-grade agricultural land should be allocated for development in preference to areas of poorer quality land, and this draft policy is therefore unsound.</p>
